Goals

- Identify and read
 - the Qal wayyiqtol form derived from first yod roots and הלך
- Identify
 - the sign of the DDO
 - the definite article
 - the masculine plu

- These are 4 'Missing Letter" rules.
 - We will study the first one in this lesson.
- These are all very useful.
- They apply when one root letter is missing in prefix verb conjugations (wayyiqtol and yiqtol).
- For all 4 rules, what you do is
 - Find the prefix consonant
 - Look at the prefix vowel

For all 4 rules we do the same thing

- Find the prefix consonant
- Look at the prefix vowel

The 1st Rule says:

- If the prefix vowel is tsere,
 - the missing letter is the first root letter
 - the missing letter is yod
- We call this a I-Yod verb

$$\bigcirc\bigcirc \qquad \underline{1} \longrightarrow I - Yod$$

(Note that הלך "to walk" behaves like it is I-Yod, i.e., acts as if the ה were a י.)

Remember that הלך <u>acts</u> <u>like</u> it's I-Yod

Qamets-Ḥatuf

Closed, Unaccented Syllable

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E.g.

- בָּל־יִשְׂרָאֵל
- יַרְדָּכִי •

DDO

- Definite Direct Object marker
- Optional (not always present)
- אֵת or אֵת
- Simply learn as a vocab word

DDO

Genesis 1:1

- Find the DDO (there are 2 of them)
- Can you guess what the words are that come after the two DDOs, i.e., what the direct objects are in this verse?


Definite Article

- "The"
- Attached to the word (not a separate word)
- Attached at the beginning (like 1)
- Has 3 parts
 - 1. Heh
 - 2. Patach
 - 3. Dagesh forte in next letter (i.e., doubling of next letter)

Definite Article


